ORDER REGARDING MOTION DOCKETS

Whereas Nashville will commence to operate under Phase 3 Guidelines concerning the COVID-19 Pandemic, the Court finds that its Order of March 13 should be modified to gradually accommodate a resumption of in-court appearances.

Accordingly, all motions shall continue to be decided on written briefs, unless oral argument is specifically requested by any party. Such a request must be in writing and shall be included in the motion or response. If oral argument is requested in the motion, but there is no written response, then the motion shall be treated as unopposed and no appearance is necessary. The clerks of the court will contact the attorneys to schedule the time of appearance.

The request for oral argument shall be noted in capital letters with bold face type, appearing immediately below the signature of counsel in a form similar to the following:

ORAL ARGUMENT REQUESTED.

The court reiterates that any motion to which there is no timely written response shall be treated as unopposed in accord with Local Rule 26.04(g) and counsel are directed to prepare an order granting the relief requested.

This Order is effective immediately.
