ORDER

It is hereby Adjudged, Ordered and Decreed that in all divorce cases filed and assigned to the Eighth Circuit Court, where there are children who will be subject to the jurisdiction of the court, the divorcing parents shall complete the statutorily mandated Parenting Seminar and file the certificates from these seminars in the Circuit Court Clerk's office prior to the scheduling of the final divorce hearing. Further, the Eighth Circuit Court requires the divorcing parents to complete the online survey located at web address uptoparents.org. Proof of the online survey must also be filed with the Circuit Court Clerk's office prior to the scheduling of the final divorce hearing.

When a divorce is granted by default judgment, the party seeking the divorce must complete the above-stated requirements. It will not be held against the party seeking the divorce by default if the unresponsive party fails to complete these requirements.
