

ORDER

Pursuant to the authority granted in *T.C.A. §16-2-509* and to insure the Court's effective administration of alleviating caseload imbalance in the Seventh Circuit Court (Probate Court), effective November 1, 2019, Emergency Conservatorships and Expedited Limited Healthcare Fiduciary cases filed in Probate Court shall be assigned to the Second Circuit Court.

By this authority, Second Circuit shall have the same power and jurisdiction as Seventh Circuit Court in accordance with *T.C.A. §17-2-206*; in addition to the same jurisdiction pertaining to Wards under Guardianships and Conservatorships as provided for in *T.C.A. §16-2-506(20)(1)(i)*.
