RE: DAILY CIVIL DOCKET SIZE FOR COURTROOMS 1A & 1B

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

To: Richard R. Rooker, Circuit Court Clerk

Effective October 5, 2020, the maximum number of cases which shall be set on the General Sessions Civil dockets in Courtrooms 1A & 1B is limited to twenty-five (25) cases per day. Notwithstanding the foregoing restriction, the Clerk is authorized to exceed this limit in order to set Slow Pay Motions only if required because said Motions must be heard within fourteen (14) days from the date of filing pursuant to prevailing law. There shall be no staggered dockets. The docket in Courtroom 1A shall be heard at 9:00 a.m. and the docket in Courtroom 1B shall be heard at 10:00 a.m. This Order does not pertain to the 8:30 a.m. Traffic docket in Courtroom 1B. This Order shall remain in effect pending further Orders of the Court.
