Petition To Probate In Common Form

Your Petitioner, **Jane Doe**, a citizen and resident of Davidson County, Tennessee, respectfully applies to this Honorable Court for an Order granting Letters Testamentary upon the estate of her late husband, **John Doe**, deceased, to Petitioner and in support of such petition, shows to the Court and avers:

1. That the said deceased, **John Doe**, died in Davidson County, Tennessee on the 11th day of September, 2001, and at the date of his death, the said deceased, had his usual residence in Davidson County, Tennessee, residing at ____ Elm Street, Nashville, TN 37215.

2. That the named Executrix under the Will and the spouse of the deceased, **Jane Doe**, accepts her appointment under the Will, by virtue of her nomination to act as the Personal Representative of her late husband's estate.

3. The Petitioner, to the best of her knowledge, affirms that the Last Will and Testament, dated January __, 2000, to have been properly executed and duly witnessed, and after the exercise of due diligence, the petitioner is unaware of any instrument revoking the Will, and believes that said instrument constitutes the Decedent's Last Will and Testament.

4. The requirement of a surety bond of the Personal Representative is waived in Item ____ of the Will. The requirement of filing an Inventory and Annual Accounting of estate assets is further waived in Item _____ of the Will.

7. The value of the estate is determined to be approximately \$250,000.00 and consists of both real and personal property.

8. The deceased, **John Doe**, was not enrolled in the Tennessee TennCare Program at the time of death, however, pursuant to T.C.A. 71-5-116, a Release from the Bureau of TennCare will be obtained and filed with the Clerk. Further, Notice of this filing shall be given to the TennCare Bureau in accordance with T.C.A. 30-2-301(b)(5).

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Petitioner prays as follows:

1. That the Last Will and Testament of the Decedent be admitted into probate in common form as such instrument.

2. That the Petitioner be appointed as the Executrix of this estate, to serve in that capacity without the necessity of a surety bond.

3. That Letters Testamentary be issued to the Petitioner.

4. That the filing of the Inventory be waived.

5. That the filing of any Accountings be waived.
