ORDER


It appearing to the Court, in accordance with Supreme Court Rule 29, a litigant who has been determined *not eligible to proceed under a pauper's oath* shall be given a timeframe within which to request a hearing before a Circuit Judge. Upon a *determination of non-indigency* by a Circuit Court Special Master, the Clerk shall mail a letter to the litigant informing the litigant of the timeframes set forth below. If neither action as set forth below is filed within the specified time-frame below, the Clerk shall return the filing to the litigant.

The following timeframes shall be imposed from the date the *Order of Determination of Non-Indigency* has been entered by a Circuit Court Special Master:


- Ten (10) days from that date to request a hearing before a Circuit Judge.
- Thirty (30) days from that date to submit an amended pauper's oath with any additionally required documentation of expenses and/or income as determined by the Circuit Court Judge, or pay the proper filing fee.


It is so ORDERED.


