

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


**WHEREAS** the judges of the General Sessions Court of Metropolitan Nashville, Davidson County have voted unanimously to amend civil Local Rule 3.01 (Filing with the Clerk) to remove the language contained therein prohibiting the E-Filing of appeals in civil matters;

It is therefore **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** effective immediately upon the entry of this Order that civil Local Rule 3.01 is hereby amended to remove the language stating:

*E-filing through the eFlex system may not be used to file appeals in any action. All appeals must be filed timely and in paper form with the Circuit Court Clerk's Office.*

Accordingly, notices of appeal in civil cases may now be filed through the eFlex system or in paper form.
