TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to TCA 4-4-125 and Attorney General Opinion 02-016, the General Sessions Clerk's office cannot allow an execution to contain a full social security number unless the attorney provides a disclaimer that the debtor has given permission for its use. The last six (6) digits of the social security may be shown on the execution. The disclaimer should be stamped on or attached to the original execution.

One acceptable disclaimer would be:

*The plaintiff and/or plaintiff's attorney affirms that the defendant has provided his/her social security number and has given permission for it to be used in collection of this debt.*
