

### Ingredients

## Velveeta Fudge

- 12 ounces Velveeta processed cheese, cut into cubes (full fat not 2%)
- 1 cup (2 sticks) salted butter
- 6 ounces unsweetened chocolate squares, broken up into chunks
- 32 ounces powdered sugar, 2 (16 ounce) boxes or about 8 cups
- 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cups chopped pecans
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

### Instructions

- In a medium bowl melt together the Velveeta, butter and chocolate in 30 second intervals until all melted. Stir until well combined and smooth.
- In a large bowl add all your powdered sugar.
- Using an electric mixer add the melted chocolate mixture to the powdered sugar a little at a time until all incorporated. Then add in the vanilla.
- Once everything is combined just use a spoon to stir in the pecans.
- Line a 9x13-inch baking dish with foil or parchment and spray the parchment with non-stick spray. Pour all the fudge into the prepared pan and smooth the top.
- Refrigerate for at least 3 hours. Once firm, cut into 1 inch pieces and serve!
