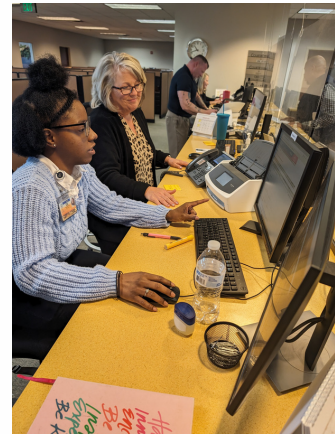

RESOURCE CENTER: 30 DAYS IN

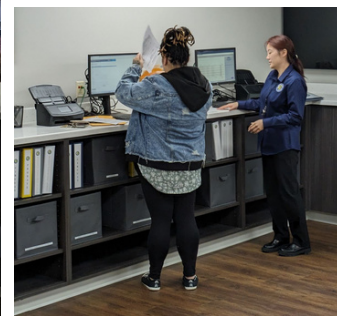


It's been over a month since the grand opening of the Circuit Court Clerk's Office Resource Center and the team is full steam ahead. The Resource Center, affectionately referred to as the "RC" provides an optimal, in-person experience for Davidson County residents who may be undergoing difficult times and need more detailed, hands-on assistance from our team. The RC assists with all matters under the direction of the Circuit Court Clerk's four distinct

offices – Circuit Court, General Sessions-Civil Division, Probate Court, and the Traffic Violations Bureau. Trey Collier, Resource Center Administrator, describes the first month of business as “an honor to serve the citizens of Davidson County by providing multiple services in one unique space while also disseminating helpful resources from our Metro partners.”

Clerk Day established four pillars for each Deputy Clerk to exude at the beginning of his first term – Integrity, Service, Experience, and Innovation – and RC team member, Victor Salomon, feels his team “displays each pillar within their office and amongst the team.” Working in a new space while mastering the intricacies of four offices and servicing the public seems quite the task but Clay Townsend, RC team member, expresses “how cohesive the RC team has become.”
