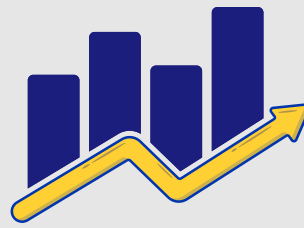

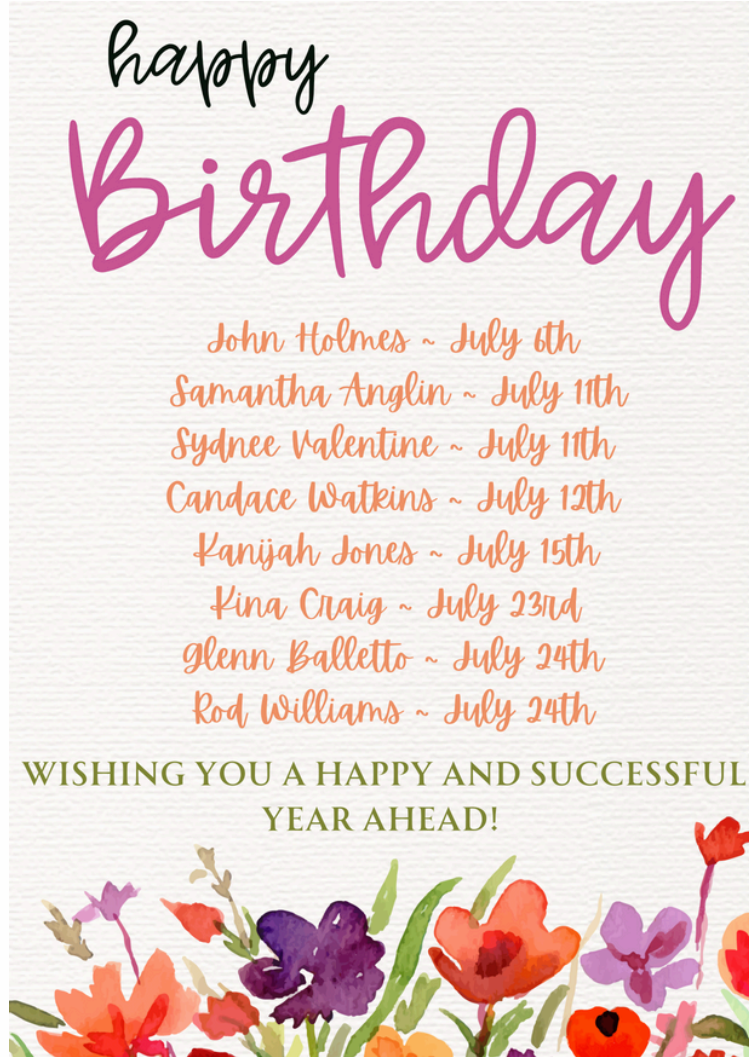
ORDER

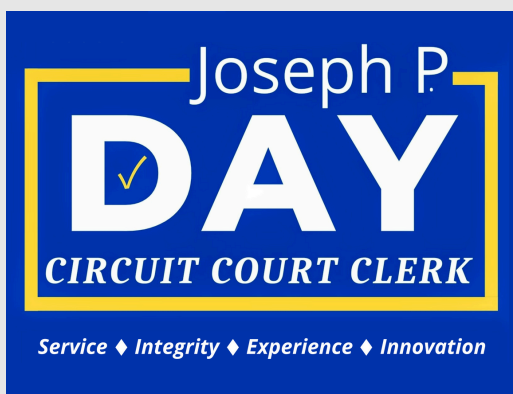
