UPCOMING FILING FEE INCREASE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2026



Beginning January 1, 2026, filing fees for certain case types in Tennessee courts will increase in accordance with Public Chapter 486, recently approved by the Tennessee General Assembly. This legislation impacts a variety of filings across multiple divisions, including Circuit, Probate, General Sessions, and Traffic.

To ensure transparency and allow ample time for preparation, our office will continue sharing detailed information regarding these changes throughout the remainder of the year. Updated fee schedules will be made available for:

TICKET RESPONSE INFORMATION

ACT PROMPTLY! You have 45 days from the date that your ticket was issued to satisfy <u>each violation</u> for which you were cited using one of the following options as your form of action.

Option A - Pay Fines/Fees; Option B - Plead Not Guilty; or Option C - Apply for Traffic School.

T.C.A. §7-3-502 NOTICE: FAILURE TO TAKE A FORM OF ACTION WITHIN 45 DAYS OF THIS TICKET CAN RESULT IN: THE COURT ORDERING YOU TO PAY A CIVIL FINE/PENALTY, COURT COSTS AND LITIGATION TAXES TO THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT; THE ISSUANCE OF AN EXECUTION AND GARNISHMENT TO COLLECT THE FINE/PENALTY, COSTS AND TAXES; AND THE ISSUANCE OF A BENCH WARRANT FOR YOUR ARREST FOR CONTEMPT OF COURT, WITH A PENALTY OF UP TO FIVE (5) DAYS IN JAIL AND/OR A FINE OF UP TO TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00). Option B - Plead Not Guilty: Request a Court Hearing

Visit http://tvb.nashville.gov or complete the Application Form and "PLEAD NOT GUILTY FORM" on the back of this notice and mail it to the address shown on the envelope provided with your ticket. You will receive a letter notifying you of your Court hearing date.

Notice: If you appear in Court and are found guilty, or if you fail to appear, the amount you owe will increase due to mandatory litigation tax and Court costs that must be assessed, in addition to the fine.

Option C - Apply for Traffic School

Only Moving violations are eligible for Defensive Driving School. If you have been cited for both Moving and Non-Moving violations, you must satisfy the Non-Moving violations by paying the fine/fee (Option A) or pleading not guilty (Option B). You cannot attend School to satisfy Non-Moving violations. DO NOT PAY THE MOVING VIOLATION FINE/FEE LISTED ABOVE IF YOU ARE APPLYING FOR SCHOOL.

Registration for Traffic School - You may register for Traffic School on-line (Method 1) or by mail (Method 2).

Method 1: Pay first and then Register for Traffic School On-line.

You must complete the following two steps on-line within 45 days from the date your ticket was issued.

Step 1 - Go to http://tvb.nashville.gov and pay a \$50.00 administrative court cost for each Moving violation marked on your ticket.

Step 2 - Go to https://trafficschool.nashville.gov, make your school payment and register. The type of school you will be assigned is based on your driving history and any Traffic School classes you have attended within the past 3 years.

You may also refer to the Traffic School website at https://trafficschool.nashville.gov for questions. The exact web address must be put in your address bar – not in a search app such as "Google." Other schools are not accepted.

Method 2: Register and Pay for Traffic School by Mail.

Follow the Traffic School Registration Form Instructions on the back of this notice. The Application Form and method of payment, along with a copy of your ticket, should be mailed to the address shown on the front of this notice in the envelope provided with your ticket.

Notice: If you appear in Court and are found guilty by a preponderance of the evidence, or if you fail to appear, the amount you owe will increase due to mandatory litigation tax and Court costs that must be assessed, in addition to the fine.

To request a Court Hearing, you must do the following:

- Complete the statistical information in full.
- Sign and date the application.
- 3. Place a stamp on envelope provided.
- 4. Your application must be received within 45 days of issue date of citation.




