Celebrating Our Team: Employee Appreciation Month

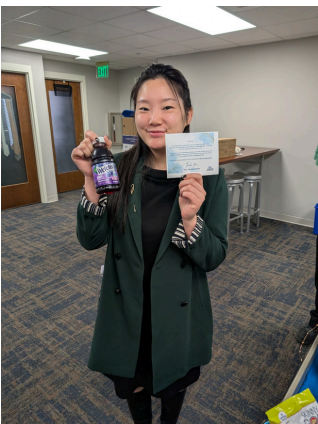
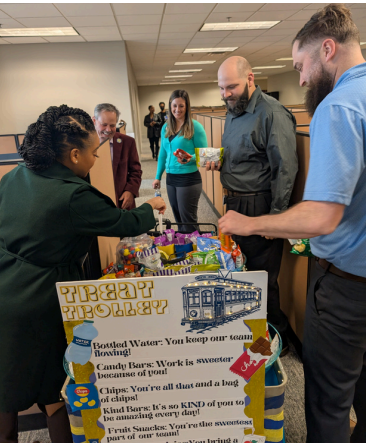
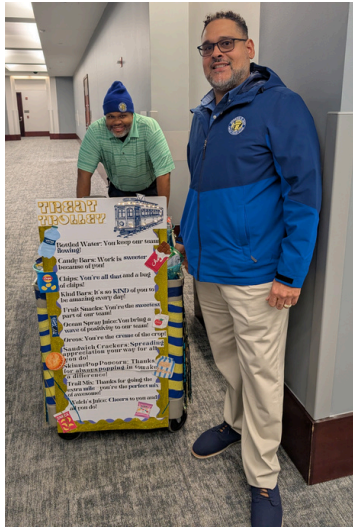
