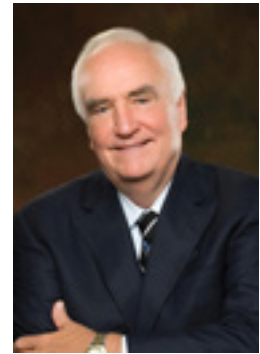

Hardin Elected President of NAFUSA



Former U.S. Attorney, Hal Hardin, was unanimously elected president of the National Association of Former United States Attorneys (NAFUSA) by the board of directors. Hardin replaces former president Doug Jones, who stepped down to run for the U.S. Senate. Hardin will be sworn in as president at the NAFUSA conference, to be held in Washington, D.C. in October. The NAFUSA announced that its annual conference, originally scheduled for Birmingham, will now be held in Nashville in 2018.

Hardin has a law office based in Nashville and is an adjunct professor at the Nashville School of Law. Hardin has enjoyed an illustrious career that varies from service in the Peace Corp, working in the District Attorney's Office, Circuit Court Judge and being appointed U.S. Attorney by President Jimmy Carter.

Metro Council Appoints Coleman

Metro Councilman Sam Coleman of District 33 was appointed General Sessions Judge of the 10th Division by the Metro Council. There were many candidates vying for the open Judge spot in Division 10. Coleman was sworn in on May 30, 2017, and will serve as judge until the 2018 primary election. The Davidson County Election Commission will determine a time for an election to replace Coleman on the council.
