Online Notarizations, E-Filing Update

Public Chapter 931, also known as the "Online Notary Public Act", authorizes the use of online notarizations which shall take effect July 1, 2019. The Secretary of State promulgates the standards for online notarizations and establishes online notary public rules. You will be able to submit online notarizations to our offices through our E-Filing system.

E-Filing will be implemented for the Circuit, Probate, and General Sessions-Civil Courts over the next few months. Development and configuration of the system is going well and we are currently in the testing phase of development. Stay tuned for information regarding demonstrations and classes on the new E-Filing system.
